INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Sponge the inside of the glass with 2 coats of the pinks. We dipped our sponge into both Pretty in Pink and Blush allowing the colors to blend together.
- 2. Sponge the top outside section of the glass with 3 coats of Gecko Green.
- 3. Dip the flat side of the sponge piece into Guacamole and tap on a few messy columns to create the stripes on the green of the watermelon.
- 4. Use a detail brush in Licorice paint and add a few seeds ton the inside.
- Paint the rest of the outside with 3 coats of your desired colors. We did Squash Blossom for an orange glass and Turquoise for the blue glass.

TIPS

- When using a detail brush, the harder you press on the brush the heavier the lines will be.
- Allow both pinks to blend when sponging the inside.
